## College Acceptance Class of 2018

91% of the Class of 2018 were accepted to college.

62% - 4 year college, 38% - 2 year college or trade school.

## Ethnic Profile

The school ethnic profile shows a student population of 43% White, 18% Black or African American, 24% Hispanic, 8% Asian, 6% Multi-racial, >1% American Indian, >1% Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander. Of these students, 1% are English Language Acquisition (ELA).

## Marking System

Courses which receive a letter grade are calculated into the GPA. IB, AP and Honors classes receive the same weighted grades.

Weighted GPA: A = 5.0, B = 4.0, C = 3.0, D = 1.0, F = 0.0

Un-weighted GPA: A = 4.0, B = 3.0, C = 2.0, D = 1.0, F = 0.0

## Grading Scale

A = 90 – 100%, B = 80 – 89%, C = 70 – 79%, D = 60 – 69%, F = 0.0

## Graduation Credit Requirements (1 credit = 1 year)

English – 4, Math – 3, Science – 3, Social Studies – 3,  
Fine Arts – 1.5, PE – 1.5, Health – 0.5, Electives – 5.5

Minimum of 22 credits required for graduation of which 5.5 can be from elective courses.

## Smoky Hill High School IB, MYP, AP and Honors Classes

There is no limit to the number of IB, MYP, AP and Honors classes a student can take. MYP classes are offered to students in grades 9 and 10. IB classes are offered to student in grades 11 and 12. AP and Honors classes are offered to students in grades 9 – 12. SHHS offers 26 IB, 22 AP and 19 Honors classes.
